New York State School Immunization Requirements

The Immunization Clinic is open **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY**. To make an appointment, use the links located under "Quick Links". To help us better serve you, please **DO NOT USE EMAIL TO SCHEDULE** an appointment.

We are currently experiencing a high demand for immunizations, and you may have to wait for an appointment. If we are unable to serve you in a timely manner, please consider the following:

- Make a vaccine appointment with your primary care provider.
- If you do not have a pediatrician for your child's immunizations: Please contact any local pediatrician or family medicine provider. Most are accepting new patients, even if you don't have insurance.
- If your child attends a school with a school-based health center, please inquire about getting your child's immunizations onsite.

Available Vaccines: Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus, Polio, Haemophilus influenzae B (Hib), Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Varicella (chicken pox), Influenza, Meningococcal, Pneumococcal, HPV, COVID-19 [Please note, we are unable to meet traveler vaccine requests for yellow fever or malaria. What to bring to your appointment: Photo Identification, Insurance cards (if you have them), Past Immunization Records, all letters received from school or work.

Children under age 18 years old must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

What to expect: There is no out-of-pocket cost for immunizations for children ages 18 years and younger. [Some vaccines may be available at no cost for adults aged 19 and older. Please call or email us to find out more]. The mission of the Immunization Program is to prevent vaccine preventable disease among Monroe County residents by immunizing adults and children and educating residents about the importance of vaccine preventable diseases.
