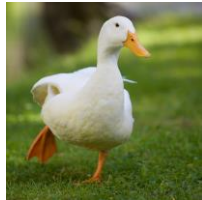
WEEK OF APRIL 27TH

THEME: DOWN ON THE FARM

MORNING

1. **Animal Walk** - Have fun waddling like a duck this morning. What sound will you make?



2. Search your house for the letter **Ff** for farm, **Dd** for duck and **Hh** for hen. Practice writing 4 upper case and 4 lowercase of each letter. Circle your favorites.

AFTERNOON

1. **Practice writing your First or Last Name**

If your child is easily writing his/her first name with no help, then try having him/her write your last name!

2. **Start your egg vinegar experiment**



- Pour about 1 cup of vinegar into jar or cup and 1 cup water into a second cup.
- Add the eggs
- Record what you see? (ex. bubbles rising from the egg)
- Make a prediction about what you think will happen to the two eggs
- Leave the eggs alone for 2 days!

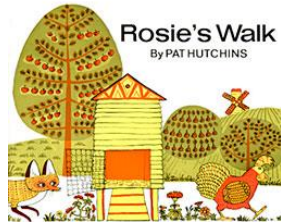

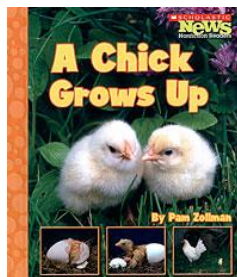
1. Movement Activity - Old Macdonald!

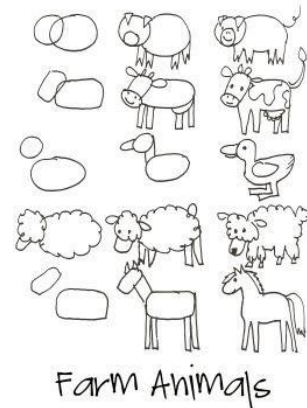
2. Read A Chick Grows Up by Pam Zollman. You will need to scroll down a little to find it.

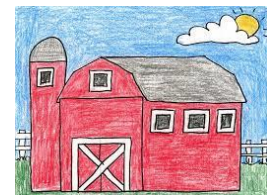
Discuss: How are baby chickens born?

1. Draw and label some animals that belong on a farm.



2. Addition and Subtraction - Draw a picture of a farm with 3 pigs and 1 horse. How many animals are there all together?

1. Cut out shapes to make a barn. What shapes did you use?



2. Measuring Challenge: Farmers measure horses using hands. What's the length of your table using your hands?



3. Check your egg from Monday's experiment.

- Remove the eggs and feel them.
- Record your observations.
- Was your prediction correct?
- Why do you think the egg(s) changed?

2. **Syllables** - Clap out the syllables in these words: **tractor, farmer, rooster, pig, cow, harvest, cock-a-doodle-doo**. Which word has the most claps?



1. Fine Motor - "Chicken Feed"

Pretend you are a farmer getting your chickens' dinner ready. Using small items (Cheerios or other cereal, chocolate chips, etc.), transfer the "feed" with a spoon from one container into another container. Now try transferring the "feed" with just your pointer finger and thumb! Which way was easier? Faster?

2. **Counting:** Count the eggs you have in their fridge. How many do you have? Practice writing that number.
