Did you hear the exciting district announcement this summer? Every Brasser Bear can receive a free breakfast and lunch at school every day in the 2023-24 school year! Gates Chili Central School District was recently approved for the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), a program that will have a transformative impact on our students and families. Under this program, students can eat breakfast and lunch at school every day at no charge to families.

· Families do not have to complete any forms for their student(s) to receive free meals at school.

· Families should still complete an Income Eligibility Form, formerly known as the Free and Reduced Meal Application, which is tied to other important benefits for students such as fee waivers and state funding, which helps keep costs lower for our local taxpayers. The Income Eligibility Form is available on our website at <code>gateschili.org/IncomeForm</code> and will be available through MySchoolApps this fall. Don't get rid of your MySchoolBucks account either! Individual items are still available for purchase. To read more about free meals and meal accounts, see our Frequently Asked Questions.



Back to School Checklist

Let's get ready for a great year – review the check list below and reach out if you have any questions.

- Interested in volunteering at school or being a field trip chaperone? Apply to be an approved volunteer.
- Review and <u>update your contact information</u> (ex. phone number, email address) in our Parent Portal.
- Review individuals authorized to pick up your child from school in Parent Portal. To add a new authorized individual, contact district registrar at 247-5050 ext. 12224 or via email at nmvaldez@gateschili.org
- If you have a student entering grade 1 or grade 5, be sure to complete the <u>Laptop User</u> <u>Agreement</u>. Your student will not be issued a new laptop until this is complete.
- All families are encouraged to complete the <u>Income Eligibility Form</u>, which is tied to important benefits that help keep costs lower for our local taxpayers.
- If your student plans to purchase snacks or extra items at lunch this year, make sure you have set up and loaded funds onto MySchoolBucks.

Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

Student Drop-Off

Students may be dropped off at school between 8:50 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Students who are dropped off at this time do not need to be signed in at the main office. When dropping off or picking up students, you must use the entrance off of Laredo Drive. Drop your child off in the side parking lot. Students may walk up the sidewalk to the side entrance to enter school.

Here's what to expect when you come to pick your child up from Brasser:

• If you are picking your child up during the school day: You will need to park and enter our main office foyer where you will be asked to sign out your child and to show Identification. Only



parents/guardians are allowed to sign a child out during the day. Those that are on our emergency contacts may pick the students up at the end of the day without a note.

• If you are picking your child up after school: Please let the office know by 2:00 that your child will be picked up. If you are unable to contact the office ahead of time, you will not enter the pick-up line; you will need to park and enter through the main office foyer.

If the office knows you will be picking up your child, please line up in your car in the lower parking lot extending onto Laredo drive by 3:15. You will need to show proper ID for us to release your child. You will not need to leave your car.

We believe you will find this process provides the care that is needed to ensure your children are safe. As invested members of our school community, thank you for participating in these efforts to make our district a safe and welcoming environment for everyone.
