Checklist for Success

- Interested in volunteering at school or being a field trip chaperone? <u>Apply to be an approved volunteer.</u>
- Review and <u>update your contact information</u> (ex. phone number, email address) in our Parent Portal.
- Review individuals authorized to pick up your child from school in Parent Portal. To add a new authorized individual, contact district registrar at 247-5050 ext. 12224 or via email at nmvaldez@gateschili.org
- All families are encouraged to complete the <u>Income Eligibility Form</u>, which is tied to important benefits that help keep costs lower for our local taxpayers.
- If your student plans to purchase snacks or extra items at lunch this year, make sure you have set up and loaded funds onto <u>MySchoolBucks</u>.

Notes from the Health Office

During certain times of the year, the health offices typically see increases in the number of illnesses. This occurs in the fall, when students are back in classrooms, after breaks from school, and at other times during the year when illnesses are more prevalent. Parents and staff should remind students about proper handwashing and other illness prevention strategies, and parents are encouraged to monitor their children for signs or symptoms of

illness. As a reminder, any student with a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher must be kept home from school until fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.

Parents are not notified about any contagious illnesses or conditions in their child's classroom unless there is an extreme circumstance that might require notification. The decision to notify





parents is at the discretion of the school nurse and the district medical director.

Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

Student Drop-Off

Students may be dropped off at school between 8:50 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Students who are dropped off at this time do not need to be signed in at the main office. When dropping off or picking up students, you must use the entrance off of Laredo Drive. Drop your child off in the side parking lot. Students may walk up the sidewalk to the side entrance to enter school.

Here's what to expect when you come to pick your child up from Brasser:

• If you are picking your child up during the school day: You will need to park and enter our main office foyer where you will be asked to sign out your child and to show Identification. Only parents/guardians are allowed to sign a child out during the day. Those that are on our emergency contacts may pick the students up at the end of the day without a note.

• If you are picking your child up after school: Please let the office know by 2:00 that your child will be picked up. If you are unable to contact the office ahead of time, you will not enter the pick-up line; you will need to park and enter through the main office foyer.

If the office knows you will be picking up your child, please line up in your car in the lower parking lot extending onto Laredo drive by 3:15. You will need to show proper ID for us to release your child. You will not need to leave your car.

We believe you will find this process provides the care that is needed to ensure your children are safe. As invested members of our school community, thank you for participating in these efforts to make our district a safe and welcoming environment for everyone.
