



Students are to interact with the instructor the entire course and be ready to answer direct questions or comments. Upon successful completion of the course the certificate will be mailed to the student and the student must sign the certificate upon receipt. Please note certificates will not be issued immediately following the course. Please check and be sure we have a correct email, address, and phone number for you before the start of the class. The MV-278 Certificate students receive is good for one year from the date it is issued and is used to schedule the road test. In addition to the basics, students will leave with knowledge of skills and habits for a lifetime of safe driving. The course will not simply provide the minimum information to pass a road test, but high-value techniques. Mr. DelVecchio, the instructor has taught auto driving skills for many years and has developed a informative and engaging prelicensing experience.

Aquatic Certification

American Red Cross Lifeguard Training

This program is designed to teach candidates the skills and knowledge needed to prevent and respond to aquatic emergencies. The course content and activities prepare candidates to recognize, and respond quickly and effectively to emergencies. Candidates are expected to swim 300 yards continuously, using the front crawl or breaststroke. They also need to swim 20 yards using front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive 7-10 ft., retrieve a 10-pound brick, return to the surface, swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the brick and exit the water without using the ladder or steps in one minute 40 seconds. The final test is treading water for two minutes. This course includes CPR for the Professional Rescuer and First Aid. Plan to spend time in both the classroom and pool each session. Students must be 15 years of age by the last scheduled session. Use door 5 at GCHS to enter the building. Class will meet in the pool. You must attend all dates. Please email dcyacono@gateschili.org for more course information or questions. You are welcome to come and practice skills in our pool just let us know when you register for the course.

Community Swim Program


